SeaTac, WA (October 4, 2016) – The City of SeaTac has published its Preliminary 2017 – 2018 Biennial Budget. Four City Council Budget Workshops have been scheduled for October and November. The Preliminary 2017-2018 Budget is balanced while maintaining the City’s commitment to provide high quality public safety, transportation and traffic service, environmental protection, community and economic development, parks, recreation opportunities and court services to the residents of SeaTac as reflected by the strategic direction established by the City Council in its 2016 Road Map.

The Preliminary 2017-2018 Biennial Budget incorporates a fiscally conservative approach to continuing the services expected by our residents, business owners and property owners. Overall, the Preliminary 2017-2018 Budget provides operating and capital budgets that are in keeping with the City’s goal of delivering the highest level of services possible, while exercising fiscal caution and supporting necessary strategic future investments.

About the City of SeaTac:

Incorporated in February 1990, the City of SeaTac is located approximately midway between the cities of Seattle and Tacoma. The City of SeaTac is 10 square miles in area and has a population of 28,251. The City is a vibrant community, economically strong, environmentally sensitive, and people-oriented. The City boundaries surround the Seattle-Tacoma International Airport, (approximately 3 square miles in area) which is owned and operated by the Port of Seattle.
